RULES, REGULATIONS, AND INFORMATION

- 1) BRING A TOUR PERMIT.
- 2) All rules of KMSR will remain in effect for the duration of the Camporee.
- 3) When arriving at KMSR, each troop must check in with a member of the Camporee Committee and turn in a completed roster showing patrol names and individual's swimming classification.
- 4) This is a patrol and troop competition. Natural patrols only. Eagle Scouts and members of the Leadership Corps may participate in the senior patrol competition only. It is not unusual for troop to run two senior patrols.
- 5) Troop scoring will be done by averaging patrol and troop scores. The troop relay results will also be added in with points equivalent to one station. Awards will be given for best overall troop, best overall patrol, best senior patrol, and best overall Webelos patrol. A troop must have two or more patrols (including senior patrols) to be eligible for the troop competition. The top three patrols, the top three senior patrols, and the top three Webelos dens at each station will receive ribbons.
- 6) In order to receive troop awards, a troop must be in attendance at the Saturday night campfire.
- 7) Each troop and pack should prepare a skit, song, or some type of entertainment for the Saturday night campfire. An award will be given for best performance.
- 8) Campsites will be awarded on a first registered, first served basis except for those units that already have council designated priority on a campsite.
- 9) No Handbooks, etc. are allowed during the competition. Don't have them with you. Leave them in the campsite.
- 10) Stations are not to be discussed with other patrols until the competition is over.
